By signing the participation form, you agree to follow the General Rules of the BATIMAT trade show and to ensure that your decorators, installers or subcontractors also follow these rules.

The organizer of the trade show reserves the right to alter or disassemble any installations that do not conform to the General Rules of the trade show or to the stand architecture rules below. Any fittings or decorations you install must stay within the limits of your stand.

You may take possession of your stand on Monday, 26 October 2009 at 8:00am

## STAND ARCHITECTURE RULES

- **Maximum height: 5 meters**

Decoration and structure: 5 meters for the entire area without recess relative to neighbors and aisles. This rule applies to all stands wherever the height of the hall permits. Any stand that exceeds 5 meters in height will be subject to an extra charge equivalent to 20% of the surface area of the stand.

- **Common walls**

Partitions separating your stand from that of your neighbor must be clean, smooth, even and contain **no signs of any kind**.

- **Openness of stands**

Stands must be as open as possible. Any special decorations must be designed so as to keep aisles clear, and not obstruct neighboring stands and allow maximal visibility through the stands.

- **Signs**

Any sign near a neighboring sign must be at least 1 meter back from the shared partition and be no higher than 5 meters.

- **Strip lights**

Electric battens (apart from signs) are not subject to the 5 meters height limit. They are permitted when independently hung over the stand structure without recess relative to neighboring stands and aisles (velum possible once percentage of coverage approved by our safety manager).

- **Slings**

Hanging operations are to be performed exclusively by Viparis technical teams.

- **Pavillons floors, poles and walls**

Any damage (eg sealing, holes, paint, marking) is strictly forbidden. Your stand location must be returned to its original condition.  
**No drilling into the concrete flooring of the hall.**

- **Installation of stands and presentation of materials**

The materials presented must not disturb or prejudice neighboring stands in any way. Nothing may extend beyond the surface of the stand. Noisy equipment or sound systems may be used no more than 15 minutes per hour and on condition that they do not disturb neighbors (article 11 of the General Rules).

## STANDS WITH AN UPPER STORY

**Added charge equivalent to 15% of the rental cost of the entire surface area.**

Exhibitors may design stands with upper stories within the space limits defined by the exhibition safety officials.

- **Warning for pavillon 1:**

Stands with upper stories located on either side of the safety aisles must observe a recess inside the stand of 2.50 meters and respect the maximum height of 5 meters (structure and sign) when the height of the Pavillon permits.

## STAND PROJECT

Each exhibitor undertakes to submit a stand decoration project to the organizer by **18 September 2009**. This project is to present the stand layout and all decorations. The exhibitor is also to certify by this date that they will return their exhibition area to its original condition.

## PERMANENT PAVILLONS WALL SURFACES

**Permanent wall surfaces must be neither painted, nor drilled nor glued to.**

All of the walls have permanent wood paneling except in pavillons 1 - 4 and 5.

Wall panel height:

- 4 meters for pavillons 2.1 / 2.2 / 2.3 / 3 and 6
- 4 meters for pavillons 7.1 / 7.2 and 7.3

## PERMANENT SURFACES OF POLES

**Permanent paneling must be neither painted, nor drilled nor glued to.**

Height of wood paneling:

- 4 meters for pavillons 2.1 / 2.2 / 2.3 / 3 and 6
- 4 meters for pavillons 7.2 and 7.3

Exceptions:

- Pavillons 1 / 4 and 5: the poles are either bare concrete, or wood or metal
- Pavillons 7/1: the poles are bare concrete

## AISLE CARPET

Hall aisles are covered with Sommer brand needle punched carpet.

Colors vary from one pavillon to the next:

- Structure area - Pavillon 1: Pumpkin - ref 39257
- Joinery & Fenestration area - Pavillons 2.1 / 2.2 / 2.3 / 3 / 7.1: buff-coloured - ref 3956
- Equipment & toof area - Pavillons 2.1/ 4 / 5.2 / 5.3 / 6: electric blue - ref 3904
- Finishing & Decoration area / Zoom - Pavillons 7.2 / 7.3: black - ref 3910
- IT area - Pavillon 5.1: clear marble grey - ref 3985
- Sustainable building management area - Pavillon 7.2: cardinal red - ref 39289
- Professional services - Pavillon 7.1: fuchsia - ref 39302
