Once the registration form signed, the exhibitor is committed to heeding any clause contained in the Stand Design Regulations, Safety and Security Regulations and General Regulations, and ensuring that any decorators, installers or contractors heed them as well.

The Organizer reserves his right to modify or dismantle any installation which may interfere with neighbouring exhibitors or the public.

STAND PROJECT AND COMMITMENT CERTIFICATE OF RESTORATION OF THE STAND LOCATION

By registering to Ideo Bain 2010, you chose a bare, pre-equipped or turn-key stand. **Before the 4th of December 2009, exhibitors and stand designers must submit for approval, to DECO PLUS and to the Security and Safety Consultant, the next elements:**

- the stand project, all fittings included (top and ground view)
- commitment certificate of restoration of the stand location

Not answering before the 4th December 2009 means that you and your designers agree to respect the totality of the Regulations of the show.

STAND DESIGN REGULATIONS

SAFETY AND SECURITY COMMISSION

All installations must comply with the rules decreed by the Prefecture and by the legislation in force. The installation of the stands and their fittings must be finished before the check visit of the Safety and Security Commission. The Commission will close down all stands which include non adapted installations. During the check visit, the company's delegate must be present on the stand (the date of the visit will be communicated later).

WOOD FLOOR AND RAMP

In accordance with decree no. 94-86 of 26th January 1994 pertaining to disabled access on premises open to the public, stands equipped with a floor higher than 2 cm but still under 4 cm must be equipped with a chamfer. For higher floors, stands must incorporate a wheelchair ramp*.

Refer to *Optional Fittings form*.

* In accordance with the regulations and the technical manual, for each stand presenting a technical floor whose height is greater than 2 cm, it is necessary to realize an access for disabled people. This access ramp must be at least 0.90 m wide with a gradient of 5 %.

MAXIMUM AUTHORISED HEIGHT: STAND STRUCTURE AND PARTITIONS

5 meters over the entire surface area of the stand with no overhanging elements over the adjacent stands and aisles. Partitions adjoining neighbouring stands must be plain and smooth or covered with wall fabric, without any type of signs.

STAND OPENING

Stands must be widely opened and all decorations must be designed in order to clear out the aisles and to allow a good view through the stands. Partitions installed along the aisles must **not exceed 70% of the length of each side of the stand**.

LIGHTNING BATTENS

The lightning battens are accepted if they are separately installed above the stand structures. The maximum authorised height is 6,50 meters with no overhanging elements over the adjacent stands and aisles or any signage.

SIGNAGE AND SET BACK

Signage must not exceed a 5 meters elevation. It must be installed at a distance of at least 1 meter from the dividing partitions in case of signage facing a neighbouring stand.

REVOLVING LIGHT – TWINKLING SIGNBOARD

Revolving lights as well as twinkling signboards are not authorized.

SLING UP ON THE ROOF STRUCTURE

Only the technical teams of VIPARIS are authorized to hang items on the roof structure.

WORKING EQUIPMENT

All equipments supposed to be running inside the exhibition area must be declared through in the Functioning Equipment Statement form.

MULTIPLE LEVEL STAND

The multiple level stands are not authorized.

FLOOR, POSTS AND WALLS OF THE PAVILION

Any deterioration (sealing, flagstone pavilion, painting, marking...) are forbidden.

Your stand location must be delivered after the show in its initial state.

All rubbishes (structures, adhesives, carpet, decoration...) must be removed at the end of the show. Any damage observed after the dismantling will be charged to the exhibitor.

The OMN company is at your disposal if you wish to contract those services (removal of rubble, floor carpet and adhesives, rental of garbage bins). See *order form*.

The exhibitor is responsible for all the external company services of his stand. Refer to the *Commitment certificate of restoration of the stand location form*.
